

ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF ST. MICHAELS AMENDING CHAPTER 54 (SALARIES AND COMPENSATION), ARTICLE I (COMMISSIONERS) TO ADD A NEW SUB-SECTION 54.2 (OTHER COMPENSATION, NON-MONETARY) TO ENUMERATE ALL GOODS AND SERVICES THAT MAY BE GIVEN, LOANED OR OTHERWISE PROVIDED TO THE COMMISSIONERS DURING THEIR TENURE; PROVIDING THAT THIS TITLE SHALL BE A FAIR SUMMARY AND RELATING GENERALLY TO MATTERS OF COMPENSATION FOR THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF ST. MICHAELS, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Town of St, Michaels (the "Commissioners") in order to perform the duties of their office must be supplied with certain equipment, materials and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners, in order to meet the requirements of their elected positions, do benefit and therefore the citizens and taxpayers of the Town do benefit, from the training that the Commissioners may receive from various state and federal agencies and from other non-profit agencies such as the Maryland Municipal League; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners feel that it is in the public interest to limit and to fully disclose the benefits, equipment, material and supplies that are provided to each commissioner during his or her tenure as an elected or appointed commissioner for the Town of St. Michaels.

SECTION 1

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF ST. MICHAELS that Chapter 54 (Salaries and Compensation), Article I (Commissioners) of the Code of the Town of St. Michaels is hereby amended as follows, with new language to be added shown in *italics*:

CHAPTER 54, SALARIES AND COMPENSATION

Article I

§54.2 Other Compensation

- A. *The Commissioners, in order to perform the duties of their office, may be supplied with such equipment, materials and supplies they may deem necessary and which they shall set forth by Resolution, which may be amended from time to time.*
- B. *The Commissioners may be reimbursed for the cost of services, equipment, materials and supplies, including travel mileage and per diem stipends while traveling in the performance of their duties. The Commissioners shall enumerate by Resolution, which may be amended from time to time, such costs that are eligible for reimbursement.*

SECTION 2.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that this Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days from the date of its enactment, having been read at two (2) meetings of The Commissioners of St. Michaels and having been passed by a yea and nay vote of The Commissioners of St. Michaels.

HAVING BEEN INTRODUCED, read for the first time, and ordered posted for public review at a Public Meeting of The Commissioners of St. Michaels held on the 18th day of November 2009, at 6:30 o'clock p.m., in the meeting room at the Edgar M. Bosley, Jr. Municipal Building, (Town Office), 300 Mill Street, St. Michaels, Maryland.


